Healing Communities training helps congregations, through mobilization of their existing resources, to become “Stations of Hope” for persons affected by the criminal-justice system. Healing Communities is a **congregational care framework** for ministering with individuals at risk of incarceration, incarcerated, returning home, or victims of crime, their families, and the larger community.

Churches use this training as a foundation for appropriately supporting people within their own congregation and responding to the devastating effects of mass incarceration in their mission field.
